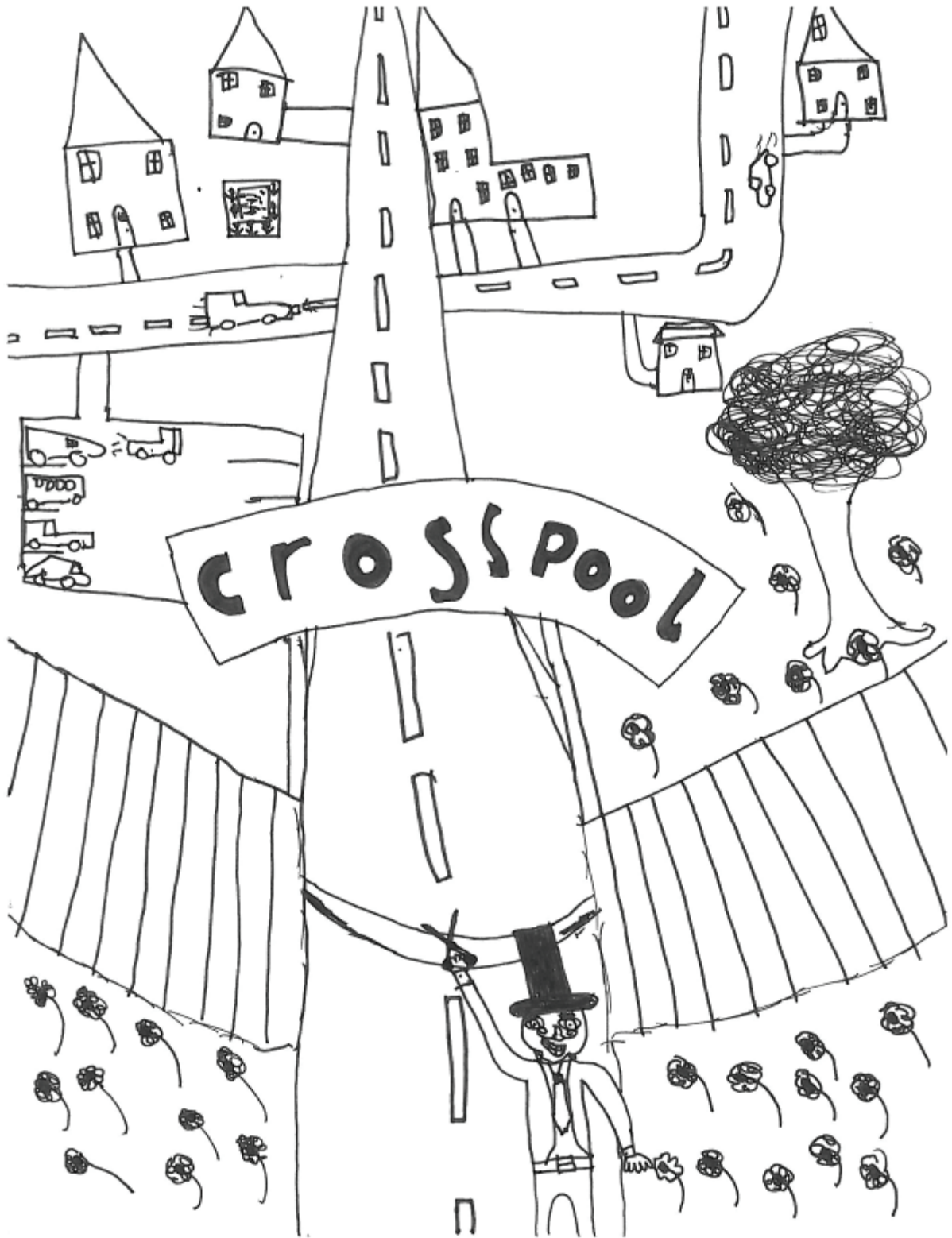


Crosspool Festival 2010
