Following recent community discussions and concerns regarding the future of Carver Fields, Sheffield Methodist Circuit is pleased to say that the Circuit Leadership Team (CLT) meeting held in April was constructive and discussions around Carver Fields' community involvement and the potential for future developments that align with our mission and values were positive.

There are no immediate intentions to revisit discussions on selling the land. Instead, the focus is to explore sustainable ways to utilise Carver Fields to benefit both the community and the church, which, while they may have different motivations, have the same aim.

To address community concerns and foster transparency, the CLT is in the process of establishing a management group, including local community groups and circuit members, to oversee the future development, use and mission of Carver Fields. This group will make sure any plans will enhance the space's community value and missional purpose as well as offer answers to questions raised at the meeting about liability, aim, management and finances.
